Judges will meet with participants on Friday evening and Saturday morning.

Any **boy** between the ages of 4 and 7 and any **girl** between the ages of 5 and 7 is eligible to participate. (Boys turning 4 and girls turning 5 on or before May 18, 2018)

Please include a copy of birth certificate, the completed questionnaire, and a photo with your application.

RULES

1. Wear a costume made of crepe paper and designed in Prince or Princess Style. (Found online at PaperMart.com)
2. Any color crepe paper, metallic crepe paper, or metallic foil paper may be used.
3. **Hoops, zippers, Velcro, buttons or any other fasteners must be completely covered with crepe paper.**
4. Leotards, glitter, and paper doilies will be allowed.
5. Paper punching with pre-cut forms will be allowed but must be under 50% of the total decoration. Sewing machine embroidery work must not be more than 1/3 of the total decoration.
6. All accessories must be constructed or covered with materials listed in Rule #2. This includes bracelets, gloves, hats, umbrellas, purses, wands, etc., and hair accessories except bobby pins.
THINGS THAT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED
7. **NO** makeup or commercial jewelry can be used.
8. **NO** scrapbooking materials, tissue paper, construction paper, plastic/cellophane paper or other paper materials can be used.
9. **NO** paint, sequins, beads, shellac, ribbons, feathers, commercial artificial flowers or pre-made products can be used.
10. **NO** illumination can be used. Shoes do **NOT** need to be covered with crepe paper.
11. Prince & Princess winners are not eligible to participate in the competition again.
