RULES AND REGULATIONS

The closing date for entries is June 1^{st} . Entries MUST be received by Wednesday, June 4th or a late fee of \$5.00 will apply. We reserve the right to reject any animal entered after this date. The cattle show is open to any boy or girl 21 years of age or under by January 1, 2025.

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 per animal to be paid when Entry Blank is sent in. **For exhibitors who have checked their animals in before 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 7th, the entry fee will be waived. ABSOLUTELY** no entries will be shown unless the entry fee accompanies it. Entry fees should be paid by check or money order made payable to Harvard Milk Days, Inc.

REGISTRATION PAPERS: All animals shown in purebred classes must be registered in their breed association and to the person who entered. All animals shown must have health papers with them which will be collected at check-in time and returned prior to leaving the grounds.

GENERAL: All breeds must be checked in no later than 9:00 am Sunday, June 8th, 2025. After the animals are checked in, each exhibitor will receive an Exhibitor Parking Permit (1 per exhibitor).

JUDGING: Judging will begin at 12:00 noon on Sunday, June 8th, 2025. All awards will be handed out on Sunday, June 8th, 2025. Only 1st and 2nd place winners are eligible to receive Champion Awards. Senior Yearlings in milk to show in 2-year old class.

LIVESTOCK EXIBITION REGULATIONS CATTLE

** ALL CATTLE NEED TO BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH USDA INFLUENZA A MOVEMENT REGULATIONS**

Identification

Individual identification of each animal shall be either a fully healed and legible tattoo, official metal ear tag, registration number (can only be used if the tattoo is recorded on the registration Certificate or for breeds where pictures are acceptable), or individual brands, if the brand is Recorded on the Registration Certificate.

Illinois Cattle

Brucellosis

Illinois is a Bovine Brucellosis Class-Free State. Brucellosis testing is not required for Illinois cattle.

Tuberculosis

Illinois is an Accredited Tuberculosis-Free State. Tuberculin testing is not required for Illinois cattle.

NOTE: Any livestock infected with scabies, mange, active lesions of ringworm, sore mouth, or multiple warts which are easily visible without close examination shall not be permitted to exhibit and are subject to quarantine or removal from the fairgrounds.

Illinois calves under 6 months of age are not required to have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

Out-of-State

Permit

- 1. All out-of-state cattle are to be accompanied by an entry permit.
- 2. Permits are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week by calling (217) 782-4944.

Brucellosis

- 1. Female cattle six (6) months of age and older and bulls eighteen (18) months of age and older shall be negative to an official test for brucellosis within thirty (30) days prior to entry, unless exempt by one (1) of the following:
 - A. Originate directly from a certified brucellosis-free herd.
 - B. Official vaccinates of dairy breeds under twenty (20) months of age or official vaccinates of dairy breeds under twenty-four (24) months of age.
 - C. Animal originated from a "Class Free" state (if entire state is so classified).
 - D. Steers and spayed heifers are not required to be tested for brucellosis.
- 2. The negative brucellosis test shall be conducted at a state or federal laboratory within thirty (30) days prior to exhibition.

Tuberculosis

- 1. Accredited Tuberculosis Free States
 - A. No tuberculin test is required. All cattle, including steers, originating from an Accredited Tuberculosis Free State, may enter Illinois for exhibition when accompanied by a CVI issued by an accredited veterinarian within thirty (30) days.
- 2. Non-Accredited Tuberculosis Free Areas or States (Not TB Free)
 - A. Cattle must originate from a herd where a complete herd test was conducted within the past year.
 - B. The individual animals entering Illinois must be negative to an additional tuberculin test conducted within thirty (30) days prior to exhibition.
 - C. Cattle that enter Illinois for exhibition and remain in Illinois (animal does not return to the state of origin within thirty (30) days) must be isolated and retested to TB sixty to one hundred twenty (60-120) days from the last official TB test date.
